## School Psychologist (Part-Time)

### Position Description

The School Psychologist (Part-Time) will be responsible for completing evaluations of students to assess the need for specialized services. S/he will be the primary person responsible for determining eligibility and recommending the proper accommodations and/or modifications for eligible students. In addition, s/he will work closely with the Student Support Services Coordinator and teaching faculty to make data-driven programming decisions. The School Psychologist is a part-time position and reports to the Student Support Services Coordinator.

### Primary Responsibilities:

- Manages the psychoeducational evaluation process in a time manner to meet deadlines.
- Determines eligibility for special education services.
- Recommends classroom accommodations.
- Writes and presents comprehensive evaluation reports.
- Contributes to development of individualized education plans (IEP).
- Helps students strengthen academic, social, behavioral, and emotional skills.
- Follows all laws, guidelines, regulations, standards, and policies.
- Knows and follows best practices for psychoeducational evaluations.
- Displays current knowledge of child and adolescent psychology research and standards.
- Engages professionally with students, parents, faculty, and administrators.

### Qualifications

- Demonstrates strong analytical and time management skills.
- Exhibits effective oral and written communication abilities.
- Holds a master's degree or higher in school psychology or educational psychology.
- Licensed or certified as a school psychologist in PA OR be eligible for emergency certification immediately
- Satisfactory Act 34, Act 151, Act 168 and FBI clearances
