



## Dual Enrollment Requirements and Application

Dual credit allows high school students to take college-level, credit-bearing courses offered by institutions of higher education and to receive secondary and postsecondary transcribed credit.

Students interested in participating in one of Avon Grove Charter School's Dual Credit opportunities should review and ensure they meet the eligibility requirements.

### Eligibility For Participation

The following criteria shall be met before a student shall be permitted to participate in a dual credit/dual enrollment program:

1. Student must be in 11th-12th grade (WCU and DCCC) or 10th-12th grade (Immaculata) and continue to make satisfactory progress within the current grade level.
2. Student must have a 3.0 cumulative, weighted GPA or higher at the time of the course approval/enrollment.
3. Student must meet one of the criteria set forth in both Mathematics and English/Reading:

#### Mathematics:

- a. Student must have a minimum PSAT math score of 530 or;
- b. Students must have a minimum SAT math scores of 530 or;
- c. Students must have a minimum ACT math scores of 20 or;
- d. Students must have scored at least Proficient on the Algebra I Keystone Exam or;
- e. Students must have passed any mathematics associated entrance exam requirements otherwise set forth by the institution of higher education.

#### English/Reading:

- a. Student must have a minimum PSAT English score of 500 or;
  - b. Student must have a minimum SAT English score of 500 or;
  - c. Student must have a minimum ACT reading score of 18 or;
  - d. Student must have scored at least Proficient on the Literature Keystone Exam or;
  - e. Students must have passed any English/Reading associated entrance exam requirements otherwise set forth by the institution of higher education.
7. Student must have parent/guardian permission.
  8. Student must have successfully completed the Charter School's application process and been approved by the Chief Executive Officer or designee before completing post-secondary schools application.
