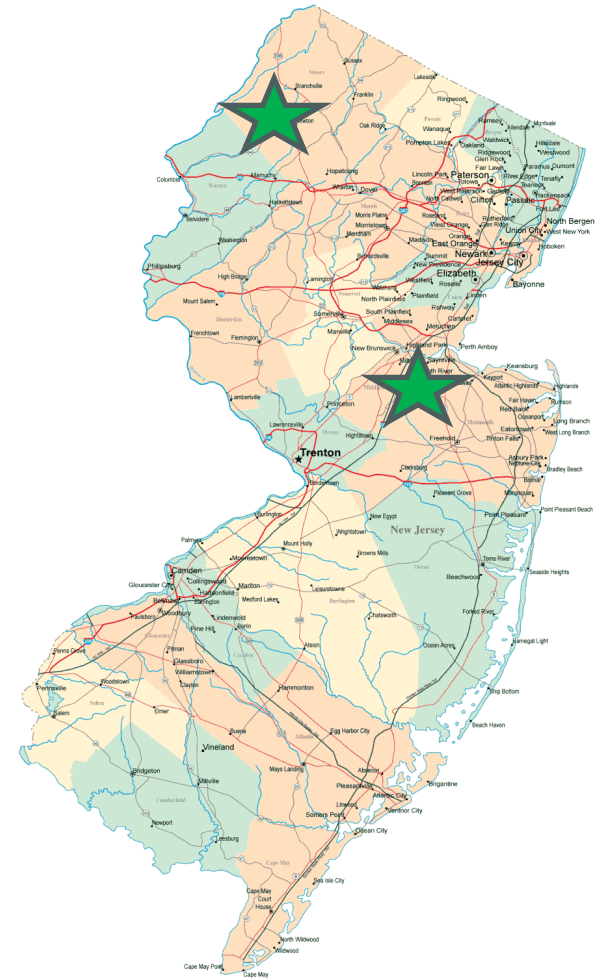

What do we do at Fairview?

Outdoor based activities where students will learn about local ecology and enjoy the outdoors.

Ridge Hike

2.5 mile hike

450 feet of elevation

Students learn about geology, eminent domain, and the Appalachian Trail



Row Boats/ Giant Canoe

Student learn rowing and teamwork as they maneuver row boats in teams of 4-6 around the lake.



Swamp Hike

Students observe an ecosystem transition and learn about the unique ecology of a swamp ecosystem





Archery

Student learn how
to safely shoot a
bow and arrow

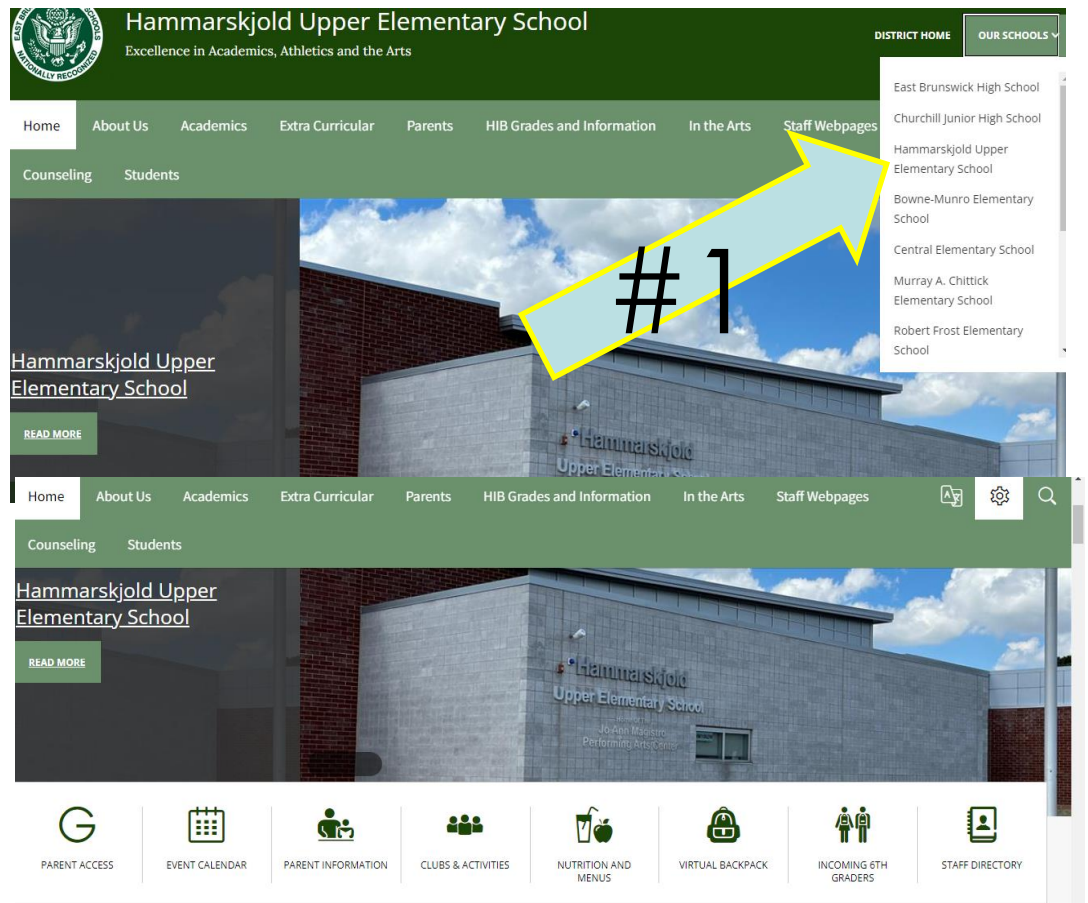
How do I access the Fairview Medical Forms?

Complete all forms for
prescription and/or over
the counter medications.



1. Go to ebnet.org and select Hammarskjold Upper Elementary school
2. Go to Parent Information Packet file
3. Medical forms at bottom of parent packet



Medical Forms

Select OTC preference

Indicate allergies

Have a physician complete paperwork for Rx if necessary

Complete preference for inhaler if necessary (self-carry).

Send in medication a week prior to the trip if necessary.

Departure from HUES

- If necessary, students will be placed in groups with epi certified staff
- Exceed the 1:8 chaperone ratio and are partnering with well trained FV staff
- All adults admitted into Fairview undergo RAPTOR Screening

Rain Plan

Trip goes rain or shine

We plan to do the activities rain or shine, but activities may be changed based on the weather.

If there is lightening, we shelter in dining hall and lodge

Row boats and Giant canoe may be changed based on weather (wind).

Chaperones

- Quality time with your child
- Selection – Randomly selected
- Child must be registered to be considered
- Will undergo RAPTOR Screening
- Must bring photo ID

Chaperones Responsibilities

- Activity supervision
- Observe and report. If you see something concerning report to a Trip Supervisor (Mr. Higgins), a Coordinator or Teacher Chaperone
- Parent Chaperone Information night is 3/27, 6:00 pm at HUES.

General Information

- The camp is not free
- No daily visitors
- No chaperones can be chosen until the students are all registered
- Process for choosing chaperones
- Chaperones do not pay or register
- **WE** select all groups-make us aware of separations
