Outdoor based activities where students will learn about local ecology and enjoy the outdoors.

Ridge Hike

2.5 mile hike

450 feet of elevation

Students learn about geology, eminent domain, and the Appalachian Trail




Row Boats/ Giant Canoe

Student learn rowing and teamwork as they maneuver row boats in teams of 4-6 around the lake.



Swamp Hike

Students observe an ecosystem transition and learn about the unique ecology of a swamp ecosystem






How do I access the Fairview Medical Forms?

Indicate allergies


Have a physician complete paperwork for Rx if necessary
