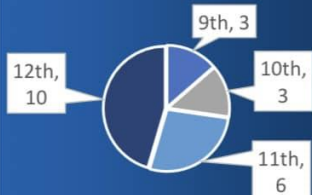
First 10-Session Update (10/24-1/25)

- Based on weekly sign-in tracking, students spent a total of 4,563 minutes engaged in positive activity at the study group.
- The average weekly attendance is 5.2 students, with a high of 10 students and a low of 3.
- Students reported areas of focus include math, civics, english, biology, and has also included post-secondary preparation such as FAFSA support and college essay writing.
- Each week students are fed so they can be fueled to succeed!
