2025 Senior Prom Contract

Every prom attendee and his/her parent/guardian must complete the Prom Contract and Permission Slip. Please review this contract with your son or daughter.

Date, Time, and Location:

- The 2025 Turner High School Prom will be held at **Hilton Houston NASA Clear Lake** located at 3000 E NASA Pkwy, Houston, TX 77058, on Saturday, April 26, 2025, from 7:00 PM to 11:00 PM.
- Prom doors open at 7:00 PM. Prom doors close at 8:30 PM. No admission will be allowed after 8:30 PM.
- Prom ends at 11:00 PM. **Students not driving themselves should be picked up promptly at 11:00 PM.**

Tickets

- Only seniors may purchase prom tickets.
- Each student may only purchase two (2) tickets: one for you and one for your guest.
- **Tickets will be on sale online starting February 24th – March 15th - \$75 Per Person**
- **March 17th – April 14th - \$85 Per Person *TICKETS WILL NOT BE SOLD AFTER APRIL 14, 2025.**
- Tickets will not be sold at the door.
- **There are no refunds on tickets.**
- An ID for you and an ID for your guest **must be shown** at the time of ticket purchase.
- A completed Prom Contract and Permission Slip must be turned in at the time of ticket purchase and a TCCHS student ID for you and your guest presented.
- To purchase a ticket for a guest who does not attend Turner College & Career High School, you must provide a completed Prom Guest Form and photocopy of their driver's license or State ID card or picture ID. The copies will be kept for our records. Copies must be clear, unmarked, and easy to read. The Prom Guest Form includes a signature and clearance from their high school administrator. Guests of TCCHS students **must be approved** prior to prom night.
- Guests must be a high school student or must be under 21 years old on the day of prom.
- Students must not have any outstanding fines or fees to purchase tickets and receive purchased tickets.
- You may not swap your tickets or sell your tickets. Prom tickets must be used by the people who are named at the time of purchase. There is no substitution of guests.
- Students who are currently serving a discipline consequence of JJAEP, DAEP-ALA, or OSS will not be permitted to attend prom.
- Students can pick up their souvenir prom tickets during lunch on **April 22nd or April 23rd only**. Tickets are not needed for entry to prom. Students attending the prom **MUST be present at school on Friday morning** to attend on Saturday evening.

Admission to Prom:

- You **must present your ID and your guest's ID** at the door to be admitted to prom based on the registration list.
- Once admitted to the prom, attendees **will not be allowed** to leave and re-enter. This includes going to your car so remember to bring all items including cameras, purses, etc. with you.

Attire

- The prom is a formal dress occasion. All students must be in formal attire.
- Failure to dress properly will result in not being admitted to the prom. It is the teacher/principal discretion at prom if a dress is found to be too revealing or provocative. If you are worried about your dress meeting standards, please see your Assistant Principal.
- If you need assistance with getting prom attire, please see your Assistant Principal to obtain information on what assistance can be provided.
- No jeans allowed.
- No beach shoes allowed.
- Dresses that could be considered inappropriate:
 - Skirts shorter than the midpoint between the knee and fingertip
 - Lace-up tops or skirts
 - Bra tops are unacceptable
 - Low cut, exposing too much cleavage, plunging neckline.
 - Mesh to the stomach; bra tops with mesh connecting the bra to the skirt
 - Two-piece dresses exposing mid-drift
 - Any top that exposes the front sides
 - Dresses or skirts must not be high cut.

Conduct

- All rules and regulations of the Pearland ISD Student Code of Conduct will be in effect. This includes the prohibition of tobacco, alcohol, or drugs of any nature.
- The administrators of Turner College & Career High School reserve the right to make any other decisions needed to ensure a safe night for our students.
- Students must remain in the ballroom or adjacent restrooms where obvious TCCHS supervision exists.
- Dancing must remain appropriate to a school environment. Suggestive or dangerous dancing will be stopped and those participating may be removed from the premises.
- The parents and students assume responsibility for any accident, property damage, or loss while attending and traveling to and from the prom.

Guest Expectations

- Guests of Turner College & Career High School students **must be approved** before prom night by the administration.
- Seniors may bring non-Turner attendees to the prom as their date. They assume full responsibility for their date's actions and will be required to leave with their date if this visitor is removed.
- Rules applying to Turner College & Career High School students regarding conduct and attire also apply to their guests.

Photos

- There will be a photo booth at prom for all participants.

Food

- There will be hors d'oeuvres and refreshments available.

Safety:

- Turner High School Administrators, TCCHS staff, and Pearland ISD Police will be on duty throughout the evening to ensure the safety of our students.
- All persons entering the prom are subject to a search of bags, jackets, etc.
- All prom chaperones are school staff only.
