What to expect?

- Student should be a Self starter
- Must be your own advocate (it is your class not your parents)
- Must have excellent communication skills (emails), since it is an online course
- Remember it's a real class (like a online college course)
- 60-65 hours online coursework: video lessons, reflection, quizzes, tests, projects (different for Fitness)
- Health includes hands only CPR demonstration

- Manage your time effectively
- Pre and Post Fitness tests in person
- Weekly turn-in fitness logs- 40 total hours
- Students will do a variety of different workout types and exercises through those workouts

- Understanding of exercise intensity- not just house chores and times you sweat
