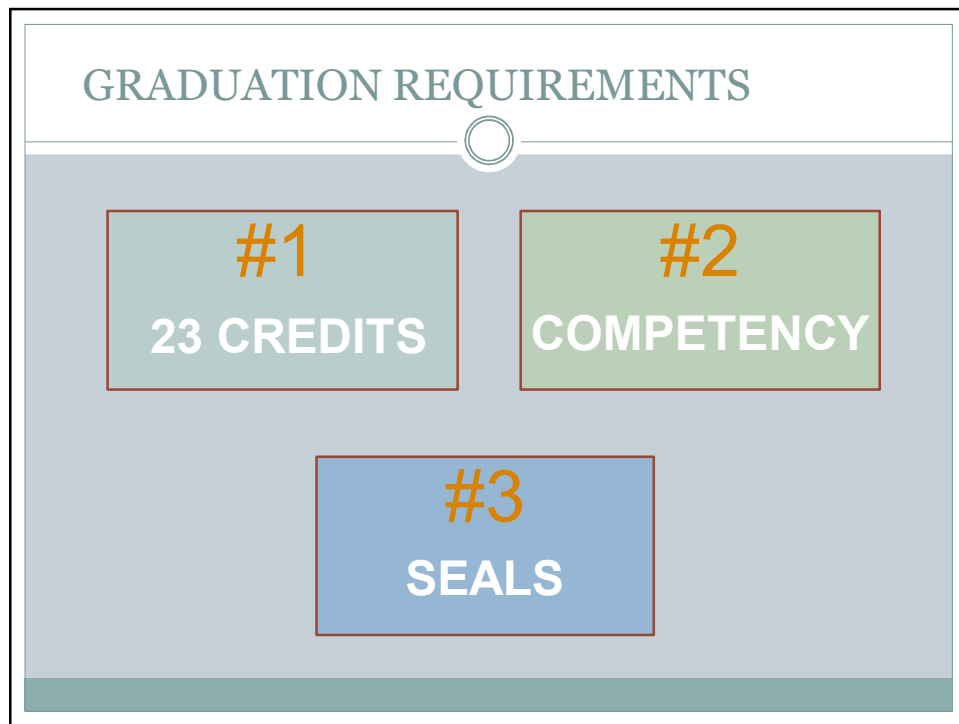

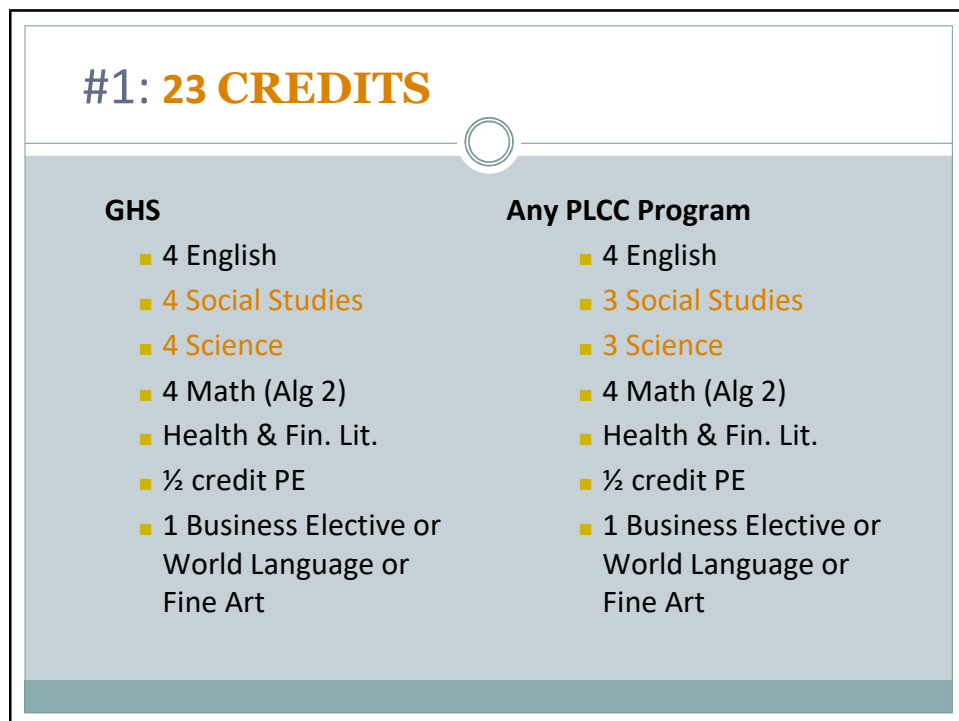

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PE, Health, & Financial Literacy

- PE Waiver- Students may be excused from the PE requirement by participating in **2 years** of:

- If you choose the PE Waiver, you can take Health and Financial Literacy your 9th grade year

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Athletics

- To be eligible for fall sports:

- Must be passing 5 classes at the end of the 4th quarter of your 8th grade year
- The Ohio High School Athletic Association guidelines are strictly followed

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Timeline

- **February 4 or 6** – Overview of high school, receive *Scheduling Worksheet* and answer questions
- **February 18** -Turn in *Scheduling Worksheets* to your social studies teacher
- **February 19-21** - One-on-one meetings to enter course requests with GHS counselors
