Transportation Services and Policies

Copley-Fairlawn Transportation is committed to providing a safe, efficient and economical bus schedule in a way that best serves the educational interest of students.

Copley-Fairlawn Transportation provides transportation in compliance with State Law. Parents are responsible for supervision of their students until the student boards the bus in the morning and after the student exits the bus at the end of the school day.

The bus is an extension of the classroom and conduct should be similar. Students on the bus are under the direct authority of the bus driver. Refusal to follow the posted rules could result in disciplinary action by the principal.

Ohio law requires children to be waiting at the bus stop prior to its arrival. It is the responsibility of the Parent to ensure student is at the assigned bus stop 5 minutes prior to pick-up.

If your student has missed the bus, it is the parents' responsibility to transport student.

Bus stops shall be limited, where possible, so that students from several homes can meet at a central point safely for group pick-up. Elementary aged students may have less distance to walk, whereas, middle and high school aged students may walk greater distance. Students may have one bus stop all 5 days per week (at the same address) in the morning and one bus stop all 5 days per week (at the same address) in the afternoon. Multiple pick up and drop off locations are not permitted. Students are to ride the bus to which they have been assigned only. We do not issue bus passes.

Copley Fairlawn Transportation is not responsible for lost or stolen items. Items left on the bus including (but not limited to) cell phones, Airpods, instruments, lunchboxes and laptops can be retrieved from the driver the following day. Items cannot be retrieved during the drivers' route.
