The Class of 2024's overall four-year graduation rate was **94.7%** - well above the state average of 85.4%. With its impressive rate, Dublin City Schools joins the top 23% of school districts and state charter schools across Georgia. The district also earned the second-highest graduation rate among all school districts within the Heart of Georgia Regional Educational Service Area (HGRESA).



In addition to these results, 96.26% of students from the Class of 2024 reported post-graduation plans. Nearly 80% are attending a two or four-year university; 9.35% went straight into the workforce, and 7.48% are serving our country through military service.

EXTRACURRICULARS

Outside of the classroom, Dublin High School has outstanding athletic programs - including Baseball, Basketball, Cheerleading, Competition Cheerleading, Competition Dance, Cross Country, E-Sports, Golf Football, Soccer, Softball, Tennis, Track, Volleyball and Wrestling. Additionally, the arts are one of the high school's points of pride thanks to its award-winning band, dance, theatre and visual arts programs. Since 2006, Air Force Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps has been a thriving addition to Dublin High School, while the campus too proudly boosts several

Career and Technical Student Organizations including: Future Business Leaders of America (FBLA), Family, Career & Community Leaders of America (FCCLA), Future Farmers of America and SkillsUSA.

CURRICULUM

Each semester, our Dublin High Schoolers take four classes, totaling 32 credits between their Freshman, Sophomore, Junior and Senior Year. However, only 24 credits are required to graduate. This means, each student's schedule has built-in time for them to take elective courses like a modern language, fine arts, personal fitness, complimentary coursework and extended learning opportunities. Additionally, they can take career education classes through Dublin High School's College and Career Academy, commonly referred to as The WAY. Course offerings for the 2025-2026 school year include: **Agriculture, Air Force JROTC, Business & Technology, Career Skills, Certified Nursing Assistant, Construction, Cosmetology, Criminal Justice, Food Sciences, Mechatronics, Teaching as a Profession, Welding and Work-Based Learning.**
