Page USD Redesign

Page Unified School District is currently a "B" District. Student enrollment is down over 625 students since 2007. As we continue to examine our current reality and look to continually improve access for our students, staff, and families, a redesign affords students and teachers access to adequate teaching and learning resources providing an opportunity for a quality educational experience. The current design plan includes closing our middle school campus and expanding enrollment for students at preschool through kindergarten at the current Desert View Intermediate campus. Students in grade 1-6 would attend school at the current Lake View Primary campus, and students in grade 7-12 would be on the Page High School campus. Manson Mesa High School would remain intact, however, the location may move. Page USD is gathering stakeholder feedback to help inform us as we move through this process. Pending school board approval, Page USD will move to implement the redesign starting in school year 2025-2026.
