EARLY MIDDLE COLLEGE (EMC) OVERVIEW

- **What is an EMC?**
 - Allows students to earn a high school diploma along with one of the following:
 - 60 transferable college credits
 - An associate degree
 - A professional certification
 - Students advance faster through education and career paths.
- **Duration:**
 - Associate Degree Program: Requires an additional year after grade 12.
 - The combined high school and EMC experience lasts 5 years (grade 9 through grade 13).
- **Blended Coursework:**
 - Blend high school and college coursework as early as grade 10.
 - Transition to a full college schedule through a Program of Study.
- **Transferability:**
 - Partner colleges have transfer agreements with most institutions.
 - Academic advisors assist in exploring transfer opportunities.



EMC APPLICATION & COURSE START:

- Application Process for Rising Freshmen:
 - Complete EMC application in spring of grade 9.
 - Acceptance notification before end of grade 9.
 - Meet with counselors and advisors for course enrollment.
- Start of EMC Courses:
 - SC Edge Programs: Fall of grade 10.
 - WCC Programs: Fall of grade 11.

HIGH SCHOOL ENGAGEMENT & GRADUATION PROCESS:

- High School Engagement:
 - Remain students of high school.
 - Participate in high school activities, clubs, and events through grade 12.
- Graduation Process:
 - Regularly scheduled graduation ceremonies.
 - Receive high school diploma after successful completion of thirteenth year, along with college associate degree.

COST:

- EMC participants can earn college credits at no cost to student and family.
- No charge for college classes within the pathway.
