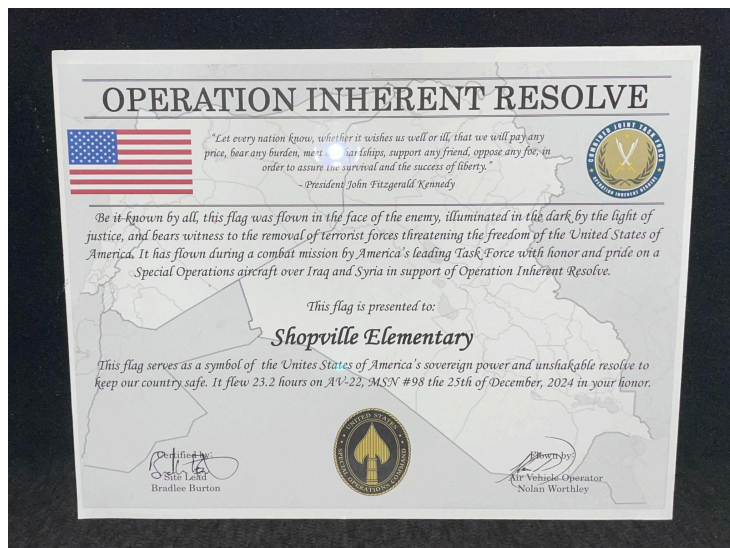
Rylan Lay and Josie Hawk have completed Finn's Mission for our American Heart Association Kids Heart Challenge. Congrats!

For the 2025-26 school year, children entering Kindergarten must be five years of age on or before August 1, 2025. Also, families may apply for Preschool if their child turns four years old on or before August 1, 2025 and is income-eligible. Three- and four-year-olds who have a special need may also apply for Preschool.
