

#### **PRESCHOOL & KINDERGARTEN** On-Line Registration is available Monday, March 17th

For the 2025-26 school year, children entering Kindergarten must be five years of age on or before August 1, 2025. Also, families may apply for **Preschool** if their child turns **four years old on or before August 1, <u>2025</u> and is income-eligible.** Three- and four-year-olds <u>who have a special need</u> may also apply for Preschool.


