Excerpt from the 2022 Distinguished Alumni Award Ceremony:

Tony graduated from Harvard after Middlesex and later received a PhD in Public and International Affairs at Princeton. He joined the State Department as a Foreign Service Officer and worked under Henry Cabot Lodge in Vietnam.

After serving as a professor at Amherst and Mt. Holyoke, Tony was named National Security Advisor by President Clinton. He played a central role in the negotiation of cease fires in Northern Ireland in 1994, Bosnia in 1995, and Ethiopia and Eritrea in 2000. Tony later served as Executive Director of UNICEF from 2010-2017.
