March 5: McTeacher's Night @ McDonald's (17781 St. Rt. 31, Marysville)



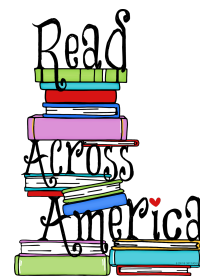

- Be ready to kick the weekend off and have fun!

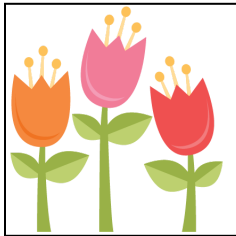
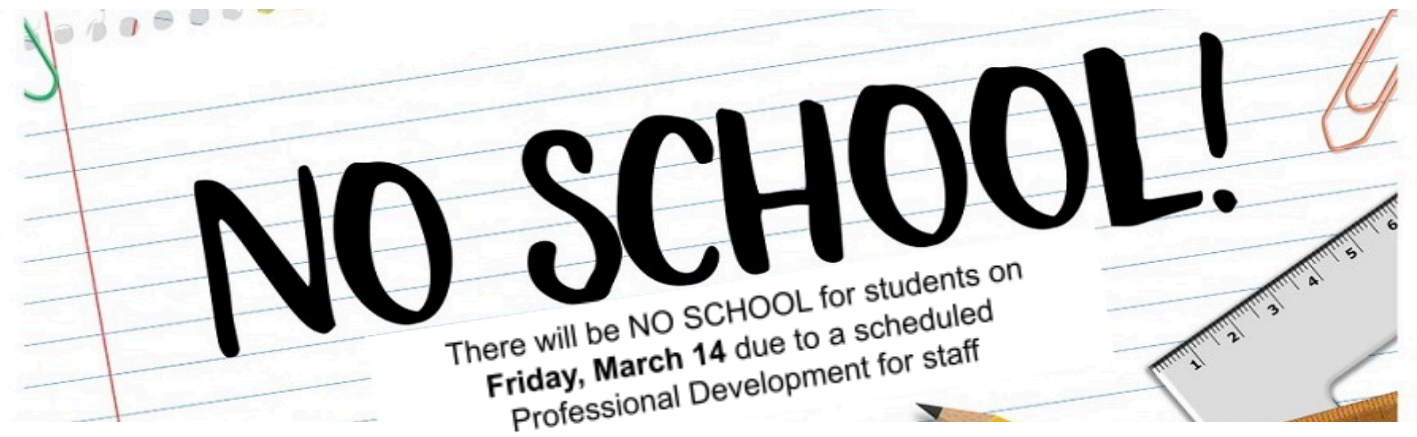

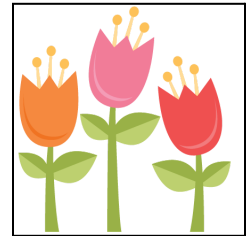
March 9: Daylight Saving Time Begins

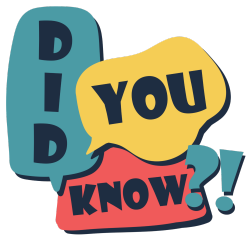
