Principal's Message

Flu season is here:



In addition to getting a flu vaccine, the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) recommends, “*Taking Everyday Preventive Actions*” to prevent the cold and flu. These everyday actions include:

Avoid close contact

Avoid close contact with people who are sick. If possible, stay home from work, school, and errands when you are sick.

Cover your mouth and nose.

Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue when coughing or sneezing.

Clean your hands.

Washing your hands often will help protect you from germs. If soap and water are not available, use an alcohol-based hand rub.

Avoid touching your eyes, nose or mouth.

Germs are often spread when a person touches something that is contaminated with germs and then touches his or her eyes, nose, or mouth.

Practice other good health habits.

Clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces at home, work or school, especially when someone is ill. Get plenty of sleep, be physically active, manage your stress, drink plenty of fluids, and eat nutritious food.

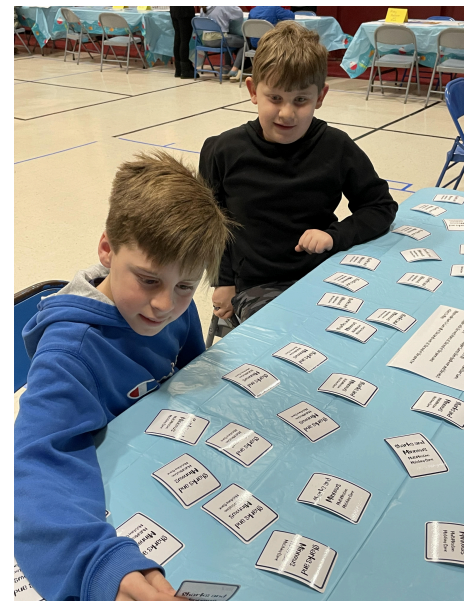
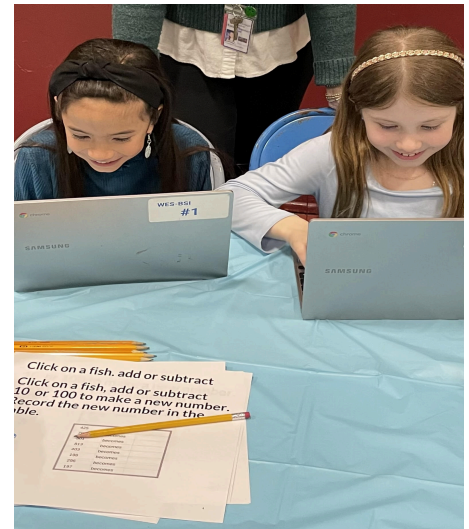
Take steps for cleaner air.
