New Business

- Informational Presentation – Human Trafficking Youth Prevention Education presented by Jessica Varela and Patsy Chavez
- Both students and staff will be educated and trained.
- Trainers will adapt training to the needs of trainees.
 - There will be different levels of training for students at the elementary, middle school, and high school level.
 - Students will have two 45-minute training sessions
 - Adults will have a 2-hour training session
- Planned for early January, the program will be presented to elementary level students in two 45-minute training sessions
- Middle School students will have training session, Inner Voice
 - 6th-8th grade will have training, Looking out for the signs.
 - Safety plan being done in class.
- High School students training will consist of:
 - 9th-10th grade will have trainings, What is Human Trafficking
 - 11th-12th grade will have trainings, Resilience, Protective Skills
- Elementary level will start at 4th grade. Trainers will collaborate with counselors to establish red flags. Social Workers and counselors will have the most training.
- A Campus Climate Survey will be conducted for each campus.

- It will consist of 3 parts.
 - Student Survey
 - Parent Survey
 - Staff Survey
- Staff Members will have an 8-hour training, similar to the training that was given in the fall semester.
- Mr. Juarez - January dates for parent training in place in both English and Spanish, via in-person and virtual, are on the district calendar.
- Nurse Coordinator provided an update on health concerns at CISD to include flu, covid, type 1, and respiratory syncytial virus (RSV).
