MESSAGE FROM MR. WILKES

It is hard to believe that the 5th Six weeks are already upon us and we have about 12 weeks left of school. The 4th six weeks' report cards will be ready by the end of the day today. Completing homework, studying for tests, and attending tutorials are extremely important. Attendance is also crucial to earning credit. Students who fall below the 90% attendance threshold may have to complete attendance recovery per the state's compulsory attendance law to receive credit. Also, do not forget that Juniors and Seniors are eligible to exempt some of their finals as an incentive for excellent attendance, grades, and behavior. Our district aims for a 95% attendance rate, which is the requirement for obtaining exemptions. The final exam exemption policy can be found in the Texan Guidelines.

Best wishes to the Texan Basketball Team as their playoff run continues tonight in the second round vs Carrizo Springs. Boys and girls soccer are in the middle of their district schedule, and both teams are playing very well. Baseball, Softball, Tennis, Golf, and Track are just getting started in their regular seasons. UIL Academics, One Act Play, Choir, and Band are working hard to prepare for UIL competitions.

The TSI Test will be given at WHS and will be able to accommodate a limited number of students at each testing session. You will receive an email if it gets full and you need to choose a new date. The cost of the

test this year is; Full TSI Test (reading, writing, math) - \$20 and each individual part - \$7.
