Visitors & Safety

ALL Visitors must check-in with a valid ID and receive a Visitors Tag at the Front Office before entering the building. The visitor tag must be worn the entire time you are on campus.

Classroom visits will be permitted with the Principal's and teacher's approval. Teacher conferences will be scheduled during their designated conference times.

We appreciate your time and understanding when you visit Lawhon and are required to show identification. The process takes a few seconds and is well worth the safety of ALL our children.

School - Wide Expectations

At Lawhon, we use PBIS (Positive Behavior Interventions and Support) to teach and encourage students to be SAFE, RESPECTFUL, and RESPONSIBLE in all areas of the school. At the beginning of the schoolyear, teachers and students discuss what this looks like in each area of the school.

Teachers and Staff award individuals and classes with positive sticks or Classdojo points for being Safe, Respectful and/or Responsible. Each time classes fill up their 100s chart their class receives a reward.

Dual Language Program Participation 2025-2026

Pearland ISD's Dual Language Program is now open to all incoming Kindergarten students for the 25-26 school year. To be considered for the Dual Language Program, students will be entered in a lottery after fulfilling the required steps. This applies to students filling English proficient slots. Spanish speaking students requiring bilingual services follow an alternate identification process. Only 22 English proficient slots will be filled at each Dual Language campus.

Dual Language Program Overview

Pearland ISD's Dual Language Program (K-6) is based upon the philosophy that students can learn two languages simultaneously. English speaking students and Spanish speaking students receive 50% of instruction in English and 50% in Spanish. The primary goals of the program are for students to attain bilingualism, biliteracy, and positive attitudes towards other cultures fostering participation in our global society. For INCOMING

*Pearland ISD employee children entering Kindergarten are provided an automatic placement in the Dual Language program if desired. Attendance to the Dual Language Informational Meeting is mandatory.

*Pearland ISD families with siblings currently enrolled in the Dual Language program are provided automatic placement in the program if desired. Attendance to the Dual Language Informational Meeting is mandatory.

Transportation will be provided based on the Transportation Department guidelines. Parents of students admitted into the Dual Language program not zoned to one of the dual campuses (Carleston, Cockrell, Lawhon, Magnolia) will have to provide their child's transportation.





Students can be considered absent if they miss all or part of the school day, including late arrival and early pick-up. This includes all tardies.

If your student was absent for 1 or more days, per district policy, a note must be received within three days of a student's return to be excused. When a student is out for 5 consecutive days a doctor's note may be required. If your student was at an appointment with a health care professional, please send the note from their office stating the date and time of the appointment.

When a student is absent from school, a note must be provided via the <u>Absence Portal</u> or in writing for it to be considered excused.
