ORGANIZATION MEETING AND ANNUAL APPOINTMENTS

FILE CODE: 9322.1

The Egg Harbor City Board of Education shall organize annually at a regular meeting after the November election on any day of the first week in January.

The meeting shall be called to order by the school business administrator/board secretary, who shall serve as presiding officer pro tempore until the election of a president and vice president.

If the organization meeting cannot take place on that day by reason of lack of a quorum or for any other reason, said meeting shall be held within three (3) days thereafter. At the organization meeting, the board of education shall elect a president, elect a vice-president, and appoint the secretary.

The board secretary shall administer the oath of office to new board members.

Annual Appointments

The board may appoint at the organization meeting, but shall appoint before July 1 annually:

- A. Board secretary;
- B. Treasurer of school monies;
- C. Public school accountant;
- D. Medical inspector;
- E. Psychology examiner;
- F. Delegate to New Jersey School Boards Association;
- G. Attendance officer;
- H. Delegate to Atlantic County School Boards Association
- I. Board attorney.
