The appraiser used Standard Costing and Normal Costing procedures to determine the historical cost of fixed assets purchased by the NJ School Development Authority as part of the construction of the new Egg Harbor City Community School. The District has obtained copies of the purchase orders from SDA and will review those purchase orders in order to provide actual historical costs and update the inventory accordingly.
