# What is WANIC/Satellite? What's the difference?

## WANIC

- 3 period course
- Locations vary: Lake Washington Tech, Digipen and other neighboring school district high schools
- No transportation is provided

## Satellite

- 1-3 period
- Only offered at NSD schools
- Limited transportation

"Hands on" experience

Great way to try on a career path before you make a decision

- Career experience
- Employment preparation
- Advanced hands-on skill training
- State-of-the-art equipment
- Real-world settings
- Meet students from other schools districts
- College credit and/or industry certifications
- Student leadership opportunities
- Experienced instructors supported by advisory committees
- All classes meet the 1.0 CTE credit graduation requirements - several classes also satisfy other HS graduation requirements
- Allows you to determine whether or not a career option is for you

# Program Expectations

- Attendance is critical!
- Complete daily homework and longer-term projects
- Turn in assignments on time
- Read college-level textbooks and practice technical writing
- Demonstrate hands-on skills/pass skills test
- Work independently and in teams
- Spend half the school day in a different location than home school
- Consider transportation, travel time, after school activities, work, family commitments, etc.
- Follow calendar and schedules of the receiving school district - often different than home high school

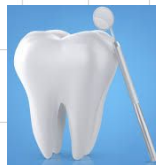

# Application Process for SATELLITE (NSD) Programs

1. Research the program that fits your interest
2. Complete the **PROGRAM INTEREST FORM** (put your NSD student email)
3. After completion, students will receive a **SATELLITE APPLICATION** via email. (if any info is entered incorrectly, the approval process will be delayed)
4. Once student completed the satellite application, the application will be automatically sent via email to parent for approval, then to counselor for review.
5. **Application Deadline: MARCH 18TH!**
6. Indicate your intention to take a satellite class when you enter your course selections on StudentVue during registration. Enter in **VNE151**. You will still need to register for 7 credits at NCHS. If accepted to the program, you will work with your counselor on your schedule.

# Application Process for WANIC

1. With parent/guardian, go to [wanic.org](http://wanic.org) and click on APPLY FOR 2025-26 FULL YEAR WANIC
2. Parent/guardian will begin the application by creating a new account with their info. From there, complete the application steps for the class you want (and time). List accurate email addresses that are checked regularly
3. After completion of application, counselors will review and evaluate your remaining graduation credits to see if the WANIC class will fit into your schedule.
4. Application deadline is April 15th
5. You will be notified via email from WANIC if accepted.
6. Indicate your intention to take a WANIC class when you enter your course selections on StudentVue during registration. Enter in **VNE151**. You will still need to register for 7 credits at NCHS. If accepted to the program, you will work with your counselor on your schedule.
