*Kids should be brushing twice a day & flossing daily

*It is important to take care of those baby teeth as they can cause problems with permanent teeth

*Students who have poor dental health are 3 times more likely to miss school
*Dentist visits should be done every 6 months from the first tooth for life
*Brush for 2 minutes, this needs to be a formed habit, time your child's routine
*Replace your toothbrush every 3 months
