- Partnership with WDMCS Foundation, and the Student Scholarship Fund, Goal of raising \$15,000 by December 31, 2024
- Scholarship is open to all first generation immigrants. Can apply in the language they are most comfortable with.
- Funds will go directly to school or apprenticeship program.
- Program as over \$13,000 for now.
- \$15,000 is the cost of an Associate Degree at DMACC.

Principal/Assistant Principal Update - Dr. Shane Christensen & Mr. Zac Sinram

IH School Report Card – School Performance Profile – Dr. Christensen

- Indian Hills has done really well.
- Overall performance is Commendable
- 69.5% is considered "High Performing" school. We are so close to this next step.
- We are above state average.
- Attendance growth increased by 5.7%.
- Chronic Absenteeism is below state average.
- If a student is open enrolled and not attending, we can send them back to their home district.
- The use of a mediator is no longer available. If families don't comply then they go directly to the judge.
- We have outperformed state average in several areas. Please refer to Dr. Christensen's presentation.

- Indian Hills has been meeting our goals for the last 6 years.
- We are above the CUT score in all areas.
- We are doing well and our students are growing at a healthy rate.
- One of the things impacting this is the IXL program. It is available for Math and English.
- 10th Grade teachers have reached out to Indian Hills to compliment on how well students are writing.
