

2025 State Testing Information


Dear Fairview Community,



Attendance Reminder: Health Office Procedures for Ill Students

Students who become ill during the school day must report to the Health Office.

Our Health Room Para will evaluate the nature of the illness, assist in contacting the parent/guardian for transportation home, and excuse the period(s) absence.





Only the Health Aide can excuse your student from classes missed, which is why it is important to speak with the Health Aide first. Parents/Guardians or the listed emergency contact person(s) are the only adults who can pick up a student from school in case of illness. Students who do not follow this procedure and go home on their own without permission from the Health Aide will be marked absent. Per school policy, we cannot excuse your student after the fact.



This policy applies to all students, regardless of whether they have a 504 or IEP.
