LEARNING SNAPSHOTS

Year 1 have had a great last week of term! The children have enjoyed learning about how Jesus showed friendship in RE. They have been comparing the friendship shown in different bible stories and have been wondering if it was sometimes hard for Jesus to show friendship. The children have been considering times it was hard for them to show friendship and have learnt that it is always right to show friendship. They passed a ball of wool around the circle while saying what they liked about being friends with each other to create a web of friendship.

Year 2 concluded many of our topics including 'Coastline' in which we did a quiz to test our learning. We also completed our multiplication and division unit and will continue to revisit the number facts we learnt throughout the year. After the half-term we will be starting our measurement topic and learning about plants and flowers.

Ask me: What did you learn during your 'Coastline' topic?



Year 3 started the week sharing their amazing home learning, there were fact files, fantastic models of the layers of the Earth and erupting volcanoes! They have also tested frictional forces using ramps and different shoe types. They have written a newspaper article about the ending of the Iron Man.

Ask me: What happens at the end of Iron Man?



Year 4 have done some amazing homework this week. There were some excellent presentations and such a wide range of work – very impressive. During the week, the children really enjoyed their robotics session at Eton College. They worked in pairs to programme a robot. They were all incredibly enthusiastic, fully engaged and well behaved. In Maths Year 4 have continued to work on fractions. This week we have covered mixed numbers and improper fractions. Finally, this week year 4 finished their William Morris topic, creating their own motifs and design. They also worked on their embroidery skills.

Ask me: How do you turn a mixed number into an improper fraction? $1\frac{1}{2}$ as an improper fraction would be?



Reception have enjoyed learning some different rhymes and performing them this week. We have been learning Miss Polly Had a Dolly, Humpty Dumpty and Five Little Monkeys. The children received a letter from Humpty Dumpty asking for some help to protect him whilst on the wall. We then spent time testing some different ideas to break his fall and then sent him a letter with our ideas.

Ask me: How best can you protect Humpty from breaking?
