

## Hallway

School Expectation: Respect, Responsibility, Self-Control, Safety

Rationale: Students will be able to walk in the halls safely and responsibly.

### Walking with Classroom in the Halls

Steps to perform skill:

1. Walk silently.
2. Stop at stop signs or intersections.
3. Line(s) on the right side of the hallway.
4. Stay in your line place, facing forward.
5. Use KHFAAOOTY.

### Walking in the Halls Alone

Steps to perform skill:

1. Have a pass.
2. Walk silently.
3. Go directly to your destination and come directly back.
4. Walk on the right side of the hallway.

# Hallway Examples/Non-examples

I will run in the hallway.

When walking in the hallway, I will drag my hand down the wall and over the bulletin boards.

When walking in the hallway with my class I will stay in line.

I will use my quiet voice or not talk in the hallway.

When I am in the hallway, I will walk.

When passing another classroom, I will keep walking and respect their learning.

I will walk in front of another classroom and make funny faces through the window.

I will walk on the right side of the hallway.

When in the hallway I will talk loudly and disturb other classrooms.

I will not stay in a line and will walk by myself.

I will always walk on the wrong (left) side of the hallway.

I will keep my hands to myself and off of the walls, bulletin boards, student work, and decorations.

I will walk with my hands to my side.

I should say "Hello" when greeted by an adult in the hallway.

If someone accidentally bumps into me, I will push them back.

If someone accidentally bumps into me, I will keep my hands to myself.

I will push the student in front of me.

When greeted by an adult, I will ignore that person and keep walking.

I will stay in my spot in line order.

I will stand wherever I want to in line, even though I have an assigned spot.

I will push and shove to get my spot in line.

I will race through hallway intersections or around corners.

I will stop at hallway intersections or corners and make sure nobody is coming before I keep walking.

I will have a hall pass when I am out of the classroom.

I will take my time or take the long way getting to where I'm going by myself.

I will go directly to where I'm supposed to be going.

I will follow the directions of my teacher or the adult that is walking with me and/or my class.

I will be disrespectful to my teacher or the adult that is walking with me and/or my class.

I will pull posters, work, or decorations off of the walls or bulletin boards.

I will let an adult know if I see a damaged bulletin board.
