Restroom

School Expectation: Respect, Responsibility, Self-Control, Safety

Rationale: Students will be able to use the restroom quickly and safely.

Using the Restroom

Steps to perform skill:

- 1. Wait for teacher to tell you to enter.
- 2. Walk in using hall basics.
- 3. Keep hands, feet, and all other objects to yourself at all times.
- 4. After using the restroom, flush the toilet.
- 5. Wash and dry hands quietly (1 pump of soap, three pulls of paper towel).
- 6. Place trash in the trash can.
- 7. Exit the restroom without talking.
- 8. Report any problems to the teacher.

Restroom Examples/Non-examples

I will keep my mouth quiet in the restroom.	I will unbuckle my pants before I get into the stall.	I will keep my feet off of the toilet.
When I get a paper towel, I will only pump the handle three times.	I will take a nice long drink at the water fountain.	I will knock on a closed door to make sure there isn't anyone inside.
I will look under someone's stall when I am in the restroom.	I will splash soap all over the sink	I will come out of the restroom and scream to the teacher that someone got too much soap.
I will hang on the stall doors.	I will race my friend to the stall.	I will pretend the trashcan is a basketball hoop and throw my paper towel in it from across the restroom.
I will stand on toilet and look over the stall doors.	I will walk into the stall, and then I will unbuckle my pants.	My friend and I will stand in the restroom talking about our weekend instead of going to the bathroom.
I will open a stall while someone is using it.	I will get one pump of soap and wash my hands neatly.	I will continue getting paper towels until they touch the floor.
I will not look under the stalls.	At the water fountain I count; "1, 2, 3, that's enough for me."	I will use a quiet voice in the hallway.
I will not hang on the stall doors.	I will use walking feet in the restroom.	I will walk to the trash can and drop in the paper towel.
I will write or draw on the stall or on the bathroom walls.	I will slip and slide through wet spots on the bathroom floor.	I will stuff toilet paper, paper towels, or other objects down the toilet or sink drains.
1 will kick on the walls of the bathroom.	I will quickly and safely enter the restroom, take care of my personal business, and leave the restroom.	I will make inappropriate sounds or comments while people are using the restroom.
