#### 1.0 Purpose

The Hazelwood School District (the "District") seeks to select a qualified Ameren certified allied vendor to do a thorough assessment of the District's lighting in order to convert the District's current fluorescent and incandescent lighting to LED lighting. The selected qualified vendor will determine the number, size, make, and type of current lighting in order to take full advantage of Ameren's LED Lighting Rebate Program.

### 2.0 Background

The Hazelwood School District ("District"), is a high performing school system in St. Louis County, Missouri. The District comprises 78 square miles, and currently services approximately 18,000 students in grades K-12 and employs 2,300 full-time personnel. The District's physical plant includes three high schools, six middle schools, twenty elementary schools, three early childhood education centers, an administration building and support services facility. The Hazelwood School District is the fourth largest school district in the St. Louis metropolitan statistical area and the seventh largest in the State of Missouri.

#### 3.0 General Conditions

- 1. The District may award a contract based upon the initial RFQ received without discussion of such RFQ's. However, the District <u>may</u> select a small number of Companies to make a presentation/attend an interview at the Company's own expense. Notification will be given to qualified proposers.
- 2. The Company must submit Five (5) original copies of the RFQ in a sealed envelope plainly labeled "RFQ: LED Lighting" and an electronic version of the proposal formatted as a single Adobe PDF file (on USB drive). Proposals must be submitted by 10:00 a.m. CDT January 11, 2019. Electronic (e-mail) and facsimile offers will not be considered in response to this RFQ, nor will modifications by electronic or facsimile notice be accepted.

**3.** The District is not responsible for lateness or non-delivery by the US Postal Service (USPS) or any other carrier to the District. The time and date recorded by the District shall be the official time of receipt.

- 4. The information presented in the RFQ is not to be construed as a commitment of any kind on the part of the District. There is no expressed or implied obligation for the District to reimburse responding firms for any expense incurred in preparing Proposals is response to this request.
- 5. The District reserves the right to reject any or all RFQ's and to waive informalities and minor irregularities in Proposals received. The District, in its sole discretion, will determine whether an irregularity is minor.
- 6. The District reserves the right to decline any or all submissions, or to cancel the RFQ call, in whole or in part, at any time prior to making an award, for any reason, or no reason, without liability being incurred by the District to any Company for any expense, cost, loss or damage incurred or suffered by the Company as a result of such withdrawal.
- 7. While the District has used considerable efforts to ensure an accurate representation of information in this RFQ document, the information contained herein is contained solely as a guideline for proposers. The information is not guaranteed or warranted to be accurate by the District, nor is it necessarily comprehensive or exhaustive. Nothing is this RFQ document is intended to relieve proposers from forming their own opinions and conclusions in respect to the matters addressed in this RFQ document.

- 8. No oral interpretation will be made to any Company as to the meaning of the RFQ. Any oral communication will be considered unofficial and non-binding on the District. Unauthorized contact by the Company with other District employees or Board members regarding the RFQ may result in disqualification. Requests for interpretation must be made in writing to the Director of Purchasing no later than 3:30 p.m. January 10, 2019 at the following e-mail address at <a href="mailto:kcross@hazelwoodschools.org">kcross@hazelwoodschools.org</a>. Any information given to a Company concerning the RFQ will be furnished to all Companies as an addendum to the RFQ if, in the District's sole discretion, such information is deemed necessary to all Companies in submitting Proposals on the RFQ, or the lack of such information would be prejudicial to uninformed Companies. The Company should rely only on written statements issued by the District in the form of an addendum to the RFQ. After the submission of the Proposal, no complaint or claim that there was any misunderstanding will be entertained.
- 9. Proposals may contain data that the Company does not want used or disclosed for any purpose other than evaluation of the RFQ. The use and disclosure of such data may be so restricted, provided the Company marks the letter of transmittal of the Proposal with the following statement: "Technical data contained on pages \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_ in this Proposal furnished in connection with the Request for Proposal of the Hazelwood School District shall not be used nor disclosed except for evaluation purposes, provided that, if a Contract is awarded to this Company as a result of or in connection with the submission of this Proposal, Hazelwood School District shall have the right to use or disclose technical data to substantiate the award of a Contract." The above restriction does not limit the District's rights to use or disclose without the Company's permission any technical data obtained independently from another source. Proposals shall not contain any restrictive language different from the above statement. The District assumes no liability for disclosure or use of unmarked technical data and may use or disclose the data for any purpose.
- 10. The District reserves the right to hold negotiations in an attempt to clarify and qualify terms of any Proposal. The District reserves the right to negotiate final contract terms with any Company, regardless of whether such Company was interviewed or submitted a best and final Proposal.
- 11. The District reserves the right to withdraw the award to a successful Company within 30 days of the award if, in the opinion of the District, the successful Company is unable or unwilling to enter into a form of contract satisfactory to the District. The District shall be entitled to do so without any liability being incurred by the District to the Company.

- 12. In the event of a conflict between the Proposal and the RFQ, the District shall resolve any inconsistency in favor of the RFQ. Additionally, the District shall in good faith decide all inconsistencies and/or disputes pertaining to the RFQ and the Proposal. The Company agrees to abide by the decisions of the District. Any ambiguity in the Proposal because of omission, error, lack of clarity or noncompliance by the Company with specifications, instructions and all conditions of bidding shall be construed in the favor of the District.
- 13. All of the terms and conditions of this RFQ are deemed to be accepted by the Company and incorporated into the Company's Proposal submission. The terms and conditions stated in this RFQ and the successful Company's response to this RFQ shall be incorporated into the contract between the District and the successful Company.
- 14. Termination for Cause: In the event the successful proposer, through any cause, should fail to fulfill the agreed upon obligations in an effective and timely manner, the District shall have the right to terminate the contract for cause by specifying reasons and the date of termination in written notice to the selected vendor at least thirty (30) days prior to termination date. The Hazelwood School District also reserves the right to procure the articles or services from other sources and hold the defaulting vendor responsible for any cost incurred.

## 5.0 Organization, Staffing and Qualifications

- a. Include names, titles and specific responsibilities of team members. Clearly indicate the Company's prior experience in school district LED Lighting evaluation projects.
- b. Give the address of the specific office which will have responsibility for performing the work.
- c. List the qualifications of personnel by discipline presently employed, as of the date of this Proposal, at the office specified above. If personnel is qualified in several disciplines, list the personnel only once under their primary discipline.
- d. Provide résumés for all personnel who will have major project responsibilities. Each résumé must include: (i) name and title, (ii) the project assignment or role that the person will fulfill in relation to this project, (iii) the years of relevant experience with the Company, (iv) the academic degree(s) achieved, the discipline covered and the year achieved, (v) professional registrations, field of registration and year acquired and (vi) a synopsis of experience, training or other experience which reflects upon the individual's potential contribution to this project and clearly indicating their prior experience in school district LED Lighting evaluation projects.
- e. Through narrative discussion, show reason why the Company believes it is especially qualified to undertake this project. Discuss any unique qualifications that the Company possesses which would be of a benefit to the District in the execution of this project.
- f. List recent examples of the Company's LED Lighting project experience during the last five (5) years. For each project, indicate the name of the organization or company, contact person, and phone number.

#### **6.0 Other Information**

The Company shall indicate whether, as a single entity or as a member of a joint venture, it has been the subject of any litigation through the discharge of its professional services. If so, provide a detailed description of the litigants, the subject matter, and the disposition of the arbitration or lawsuit. The District pledges absolute confidentiality on all litigation disclosed.

- > The Company must complete Attachment 1, "Company Identification Form."
- The Company must complete Attachment 2, "References and Experience," including a listing of all Missouri school districts and companies for which the company currently and in the past provided LED Lighting evaluation projects. The Company should provide information on projects of a similar nature to that described in this RFQ. Information on projects shall include the year the system was implemented. The references should include at least one contract currently in force with a district similar in size and population to the Hazelwood School District.
- ➤ The Company must complete Form A and Form B from Attachment 3, Supplier Diversity Program.

#### Wage Rates

- A. Prevailing wage rates for the St. Louis area shall apply to this work project. Prevailing wage rates will be supplied to the successful bidder. The successful vendor will have to comply in full with all requirements of the Prevailing Wage Law.
- B. Copies of the contractor's payroll may have to be furnished to the owner.
- C. The contractor will have to supply the necessary affidavit of compliance prior to receiving payment.
- D. The contractor will forfeit as a penalty to Hazelwood School District, ten dollarl (\$10) for each worker employed, for each calendar day, or portion thereof, such worker is paid less than the said stipulated rates for any work done under a said contract, by the contractor or by any subcontractor under them.
- E. All contractor's bonds will include such provision as will guarantee the faithful performance of the prevailing wage clauses as provided by contract.

#### 7.0 Scope of Work: Ability to Implement Project

- Identify timeline and any costs to the District to:
- Assess and count lighting at the three (3) high schools: Hazelwood East, Hazelwood West, and Hazelwood Central.
- Assess and count lighting at five (5) middle Schools: Central Middle, North Middle, West Middle, Northwest Middle, and Southeast Middle.
- Assess and count lighting at twenty (20) elementary schools: Lusher, Walker, McNair, McCurdy, Armstrong, Russell, Garrett, Jana, Barrington, Brown, Jury, Keeven, Granneman, Arrow Point, Cold Water, Larimore, Lawson, Jamestown, Townsend, Twillman. Assess and count lighting at three (3) Early childhood Schools: ECE West, ECE East, and ECE Central/Galactic/TLC.
- The selected vendor will be expected to provide a detailed breakdown for each location to be classified by classroom, administration offices, hallways, lunchroom, utility room, gymnasium, outside lighting, restrooms, and conference rooms. Please provide an example based on this project or a <u>previously completed</u> project.
- The selected vendor will be expected to provide a detailed LED replacement that will meet or exceed current lighting, which will include manufacturer's name, model/product number, wattage, unit cost, rebate per unit. Please provide an example based on this project or a <u>previously completed</u> project.
- Provide an example based on this project or a previously completed project which:
  - Describes baseline methodology and calculations.
  - Describes methods used to calculate costs and savings.
  - Describes scheduling methods and potential timeline.
  - Describes approach to project financing and options.
  - Describes warranty coverage.
  - Describes approach to sub-contractors and vendors.
  - Describes project management overview.
  - Describes scheduling methods and potential timeline.

### 8.0 Written Agreement

The selected vendor must be willing to enter into an agreement with the District and agree to all terms in the Agreement for Contracted Services. Respondents are advised that the District is not bound by the terms of the RFQ until a written agreement is fully executed and any activity taken by Respondent prior to a written agreement being fully executed is done at the Respondent's sole risk.

#### 9.0 Pricing/Costs/Fees

Proposed fees includes all supervision, labor, materials, tools, equipment, supplies, services insurance, all-inclusive transportation (lodging and meals included), annual maintenance and support, other incidental requirements necessary conduct the assessment, in accordance with the RFQ for LED Lighting as outlined in the scope of work.

## 10.0 Evaluation and Scoring Criteria

Proposals will be evaluated, scored, and ranked by a Selection Committee with a maximum score of 100 points. The Selection Committee may invite up to the top three (3) ranked proposals for an interview or may choose to move forward to the equipment test period of the top two highest scoring firms. The purpose of the interview is for clarification and verification of the written proposal. The Selection Committee may re-score the proposal after the interview, but may not re-score pricing /costs/fees, unless the Committee requests a best and final offer.

Proposals will be evaluated, scored, and ranked on the following criteria:

**20 Points** – <u>Qualifications:</u> Expertise of the firm demonstrated ability to meet the scope of the work.

**15 Points** – Technical capability

**20 Points** – Ability to implement project

**10 Points** – <u>Strength of References:</u> Quality and applicability of feedback received from references.

#### **10 Points** – RFQ Responsiveness:

- Completeness and conformity of the proposal to the RFQ's requirements.
- The respondent's demonstrated ability to perform the required services.
- The respondent's indication of its understanding of the purpose and scope of the proposed services as evidenced by the quality of the proposal submitted.

#### **15 Points** – Costs and Fees

**10 Points** – <u>MBE/WBE Participation:</u> Any included MWBE participation must meet the District's Supplier Diversity Program guidelines. See the attached Supplier Diversity Guidelines.

**100 Points** – <u>Total available number of evaluation points.</u>

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#### SUPPLIER DIVERSITY

The Hazelwood School District has established a Supplier Diversity Program to provide opportunities for the meaningful participation of Minority Business Enterprises (MBE) and Women Business Enterprises (WBE) in purchase made by the District. The District has established <u>minimum</u> goals of fifteen percent (15%) for MBE and five percent (5%) for WBE utilization for all supplier of professional services and consultant.

A supplier of professional services or consultant, who has achieved the participation goals for MBE/WBES, as defined herein, will be in compliance with the requirements of the specification. A supplier of professional services or consultant who cannot achieve the goals for MBE/WBE participation must be able to demonstrate that the required positive efforts were initiated prior to submittal of the proposal. If the business partner cannot demonstrate the required positive efforts, the proposal will be rejected as non-responsive.

The District will accept, as prospective MBE/WBE participants for these projects, only those MBE/WBE firms which have been certified by one or more of the following agencies on or before the date of the bid opening:

- 1. City of St. Louis (St. Louis Development Corporation/Airport Authority)
- 2. St. Louis Minority Supplier Development Council (SLMSDC)
- 3. Missouri Regional Certification Committee (MRCC)
- 4. State Certifications, e.g., the State of Missouri and other states
- 5. National Minority Supplier Development Council (NMSDC)
- 6. Women Business Enterprise National Council (WBENC) and its affiliates

In the case of a manufacturer, the District will also accept MBE/WBE certification by any state division of purchasing or the National Minority Supplier Development Council and its affiliates.

The School District reserves the right to reject any certification if it is discovered that the same entity was denied certification by any of the other agencies listed above. If the Hazelwood School District does not accept a MBE or WBE's certification, the district will notify the MBE or WBE in writing.

## Attachment 1: Company Identification Form

Designate one individual as the Company's representative to the District during the term of the Agreement. The representative will be contacted to solve any and all problems that may arise concerning the Proposal during the evaluation period. The undersigned Company hereby agrees to be bound by the terms of the RFQ and that the enclosed Proposal is submitted in accordance therewith. Once completed and returned, this Proposal becomes the primary basis for evaluation and selection of the Company to provide the services required by the District for the specified period. 
