The bid will be awarded on the basis of price for quality, along with the consideration of firm prices. All prices are to include delivery. We are asking for an option to renew for a second year; 2019-2020.

The enclosed bid sheet contains our estimates for the next twelve months. Payment will be made only for merchandise and service requested and received.

Interested parties should submit in a sealed envelope marked **“Transportation Supplies Bid (Oil)”** to reach my office on or before **Tuesday, September 4, 2018** not later than **10:30 a.m.** Prices must include delivery to the Transportation Department on an as needed basis, ordered with a properly executed purchase order.

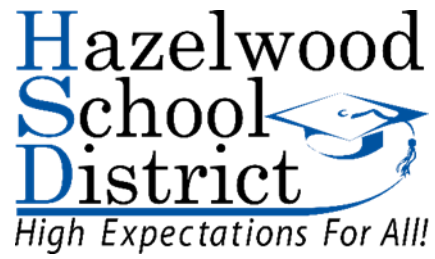

Supplier Diversity Program

The Hazelwood School District has established a Supplier Diversity Program to provide opportunities for the meaningful participation of Minority Business Enterprises (MBE) and Women Business Enterprises (WBE) in purchases of made by the District. The District has established a MBE goal of fifteen percent (15%) and a WBE goal of five percent (5%) utilization for all manufacturers, suppliers of goods, and brokers.

A manufacturer, supplier of goods, or broker who has achieved the participation goals for MBE/WBEs, as defined herein, will be in compliance with the requirements of this specification. A manufacturer, supplier of goods, or broker who cannot achieve the goals for MBE/WBE participation must be able to demonstrate that the required positive efforts were initiated prior to submittal of the proposal. If the business partner cannot demonstrate the required positive efforts, the proposal will be rejected as non-responsive.

The District will accept, as prospective MBE/WBE participants for these projects, only those MBE/WBE firms which have been certified by one or more of the following agencies on or before the date of the bid opening:

1. City of St. Louis (St. Louis Development Corporation/Airport Authority)
2. St. Louis Minority Business Council (SLMBC)
3. Women's Business Enterprise National Council (WBENC) and its affiliates
4. State Certifications, e.g., State of Missouri
5. Missouri Regional Certification Committee (MRCC)
6. National Minority Supplier Development Council (NMSDC)

In the case of a manufacturer, the District will also accept MBE/WBE certification by any state division of purchasing or the National Minority Supplier Development Council and its affiliates.

HSD reserves the right to reject any certification if it is discovered that the same entity was denied certification by any of the other agencies listed above. If HSD does not accept a MBE or WBE's certification, HSD will notify the MBE or WBE in writing.
