- **Civics Bee**: A competition where students demonstrate their knowledge of civic processes while engaging in meaningful discussions about community issues.
- **Student Action Teams**: Groups where students identify and implement projects that address real-world challenges and positively impact their community.
- **STLP: The Student Technology Leadership Program (STLP)** empowers students to use technology creatively and collaboratively to solve real-world problems, showcase their skills, and develop leadership abilities.
- **KUNA**: **The Kentucky United Nations Assembly (KUNA)** is a student-led program that immerses middle and high school students in global issues through a simulation of the United Nations, where they represent countries, debate international topics, and develop leadership skills.
- **KYA: Kentucky Youth Assembly (KYA)** is a student-led program that provides middle and high school students with hands-on experience in democracy, allowing them to engage in mock legislative sessions, debate real-world issues, and develop leadership skills.
- **Student Ambassadors**: A select group of students who serve as the welcoming committee for Crawford. They give school tours to prospective families and students, providing a firsthand look at campus life, and offer mini-orientations to help newcomers feel at home. Ambassadors play a key role in making Crawford a friendly and inviting place for all.
- **Student Government**: A student-led organization that empowers students to have a voice in shaping school policies, events, and activities. Student government members will also have the opportunity to contribute to resolving issues on campus by serving peer review board, and promoting fairness and accountability within the school.


## Accelerated Learning Opportunities



- Accelerated Math: Tailored to meet all needs, students will build a strong foundation in mathematical concepts, critical thinking, and problem-solving skills, preparing them for higher-level math courses, offering opportunities for high school-level credit in Algebra I and Geometry.
- Accelerated Literacy and Language: An opportunity designed to boost language proficiency through high school courses in Spanish 1, Spanish for Heritage Speakers, and Chinese 1, focusing on reading, writing, speaking, and cultural understanding. Students can also earn high school-level credit in English 1, strengthening their literacy skills in reading, composition, and analysis preparing students for success in a globalized world while deepening cultural appreciation.
- Accelerated Pathway Offerings: Focused on critical thinking, writing, and public speaking, our elective programs prepare students for future academic success.
