#### 5. COMMITTEE REPORTS

Operations & Finance Committee

- Good evening everybody. We had a meeting on January 22nd, we talked about a few different things in our committee. The 1st is enrollment. You'll be proud to know that our enrollment applications are almost double what they were a year at this time. We've got 452 applications for enrollment in the next school year. We have a number of upcoming enrollment and recruitment events, including multiple open houses both virtual and in person. We also have a number of targeted recruiting events, including events targeting our 8th graders who are in the village already. Moving on to technology, we have 821 incident IQ. These are tickets that are mostly Chromebook related that we have closed out for this school year. On the facility side, our boilers are all functional. Our staff is being trained on how to operate all the different systems. We've also completed fire inspections across all four of our buildings. Moving on to finance, you'll notice that we're putting forth our normal build list, but also we're reviewing a few different reports. I'm going to give you a couple highlights from some of the finance reports. The first thing I'll point out is that when you look at our Treasures report, you'll see that our cash balance is higher than a month prior by about just under 400 K higher. And from a year ago, our cash balance today is almost \$2,000,000 higher than it was one year ago and almost \$4 million higher than where it was two years ago. So our financial footing is really solid. Our fund balance, which includes cash and also money that we will get in the future is higher than it was a year ago by almost a million dollars and higher than it was two years ago by almost \$5 million. Again, our fund balance is looking really good. Finally, just looking at our budget for the year, we have budgeted deficit this year of just under 1.9 or 1.8 million. And right now we're projecting a smaller deficit of about 1.2 million. But we again are in solid footing. We reviewed all of our grants and we've also made sure that the SBA and the staff is aware that it is our intention to utilize every penny of every grant that we have access to for the benefit of the young people in the in the village. One thing I want to brag about in our committee, we did a review of how much cash we should be keeping in our checking account versus how much could go into a money market account and we as a committee decided to move more cash into the money market and we made an extra \$7000 less month that just from simply moving money from one account within the same bank into another account. So that is our Finance Committee and also operations report, any questions or comments? (Boomer)
  - Yes, I think it's great news that we have doubled the amount of people who want to apply to become a part of the village. That's some good news for us to publicize and for us to know that information. (Rouse)
    - Absolutely. And also just my hat is off to the folks that are involved in enrollment. It's a lot of work and you know you are trying to create a message in the marketplace using advertising and also word of mouth and you know it's a lot of tireless work and I just appreciate all the effort that goes in. (Boomer)

#### Personnel Committee

• On January 16th, the Personnel Committee met at 5:00 PM with Mr. Abbaleo and we were introduced to our new Director of Human Resources, Miss Cynthia Migosi. Welcome to the village, Miss Migosi. I have a few brief updates to share with you for concerning our meeting. Our payroll has now returned back to the district in house. Array the SBO office is no longer providing the service for the district. So with the effort to recruit and attract top talent, we have 3 hiring fairs coming up. NJ School Jobs, which has already took place. We have one at Keen University, and there's also another one that will be attended by our team as well. We also discussed and reviewed the district's vacancies. Last month we had a total of 16 vacancies, which is a little higher than the month before which was 14 so just two over that. At Sankofa Academy, there is no change. At Pac, there are 7 vacancies. At Steam Academy, there are two vacancies. It decreased one from last month and at the high school, the Culinary performing arts, there are 7 vacancies. Lastly, we discussed the transition update of the high school floor plan and we have one action item for the board to approve tonight, which is our January 2025 Personal action list. And this concludes our personnel. I will say that all of our committee participants were in attendance, Vice Chair Miss Carter and myself was in attendance at this meeting. And that's our report for tonight. (Rouse)

#### Curriculum & Instruction Committee

- Good evening everyone. The committee met on January the 14th and we were really treated with
  the testing procedures that you received tonight. So we went over that as well in our meeting.
  Tonight we only have two items for resolution, unless Mr. Abbaelo you have something to add. We
  have two items for field trips and for home instruction that we would need a resolution on. That is 27
  F and 27 G. (Towe)
  - I'm sorry that guy changed slightly so that there are no field trips that are up for resolution tonight. One is for students who are on home instruction and then another is for a home instruction contract for an individual student who's receiving outpatient services. So that, yeah, there was a mix of that field trip one was earlier today, but they sent a revised version out. (Abbaleo)
    - Alright, so I revise that actually, we just have the home instruction resolution for those students, either for hospital stay or they're just out of there away from us. So we have to resolve that.(Towe)
      - Yep. And they're getting bedside instruction at a hospital. (Abbaleo)
        - So then that means F is out and we're just looking at G, so I guess I make a resolution then a recommendation for item 127 G. (Towe)
          - Yes, so 127 G just for clarity, if you guys see on the agenda that's the approval of the Home instruction student. (Griffiths)

#### Culture & Climate + Alumni Committee

• Good evening. I have a really quick report out. The alumni committee met on January 14. Myself, Ms. Ince, Mr. Valdivieso, Ms. Carla Wynter-Darius, Ms. Vanessa Jean Lewis, and Mr. Mickens was not there in attendance. But we have some exciting news, we elected our Student Council president for this year, "Penelope Harr Zapata". I am hoping I'm pronouncing your name correctly. I do have her bio, so I'm happy to circulate that to the board for whoever's interested. She will be joining the board as a student representative in upcoming meetings, so look forward to seeing her and having her on our board as well. Also, we have some really great things coming out of the college and career office. On



instant decision day, we had 11 acceptances from BCMSU. I'm not remembering which college that is, but that's not the most exciting news. The most exciting news is that we have a bunch of other acceptances for grammar pro. We went to a HBCU fair at Kean. We got 37 acceptances from there. We get college tours for 2 lvy League schools, Columbia University and the University of Pennsylvania and Ms. Jonte Lewis said that we received over \$1,000,000 in scholarship offers so far. That is incredible news coming out of our college and careers office. Thank you so much for all the hard work that you're doing to make sure that our students are not only applying to college, but also applying for scholarships and securing those scholarships. Thank you. And that completes my report. (Gilchrist)
