Art

Bucheit: Ceramics

All Ceramics students <u>will need supplies</u> and have a set of usable Clay/Ceramic tools, a small sponge, a set of soft paintbrushes of assorted sizes, and a paint tray (a foam egg carton would work).

Intro 2D and 3D

Supplies for class are basic items for school-pen, pencil, eraser, notebook paper...

Supplies needed.... Ruler, set of 3 or more soft paint brushes, paint tray (a foam egg carton would work fine for this), cover apron or shirt for painting, scissors and a few other items for specific projects. Students will ALWAYS be notified ahead of time of any new supplies needed to be provided by them for a project.

Drawing

Supplies needed – Sketchbook (required) at least 8x10, but not gigantic, eraser, ruler

Painting

Various paint brushes – SOFT, the more and different sizes and shapes the better, paint tray (foam or plastic egg cartons work great) water cup for rinsing brushes. May want a cover apron or shirt, ruler, eraser, sketchbook (required) at least 8x10 not gigantic

Photography

Photography class does REQUIRE a digital camera, phones will not be allowed, must not be a point & shoot camera but an SLR/adjustable style camera.

The school does have these cameras that can be checked out and borrowed for this class with the technology department.

Advanced art 2D & 3D and AP 2D & 3D

This will depend on what your student is planning to do for their main work. Paint brushes and trays will need to be provided by the student. Paint thinner, glass container if oil painting. Clay tools if going to work in clay.

Basic drawing supplies are provided, paper, pencils, paint panels, paint...etc. More will be discussed in the first days of class.
