Dear Parents and Guardians:

Along with school districts across the state of Ohio, the Parma City School District will be administering Ohio's State Tests during the months of March through May. The Parma City School District plans to administer Ohio's State Tests on-line via student laptops. Students are required, by State law, to test based on their current academic coursework. Test performance impacts graduation eligibility, academic seal obtainment, and diploma type. For more information please visit the Ohio Department of Education and Workforce's [testing website](#).

State assessments will be administered on the following dates and in the following subject areas at Normandy and Valley Forge High Schools	
Wednesday, March 5th	SAT- All 11th grade students attend school. Students are released after testing. No make-up date for this test. No school for students in grades 9,10, and 12.
Wednesday, April 16th	English Language Arts II (Part I) All other students report for class at 10:02. See schedule on page 2.
Thursday, April 17th	English Language Arts II (Part II) All other students report for class at 10:02. See schedule on page 2.
Monday, April 28th*	U.S. History Government Non-testing students do not attend school
Wednesday, April 30th*	Algebra I Geometry Non-testing students do not attend school
Friday, May 2nd*	Biology Non-testing students do not attend school

Normandy and Valley Forge have planned a delayed start for the English test dates only (April 16, 17). March 5, April 28, 30, and May 2 are test days only and students who are required to test on any or all of the above days must arrive at the regularly scheduled start time, non-testers do not attend school. Test takers will leave school after the testing is complete. PVLA students must test in-person following the same schedule at their home school. Please contact your child's school for specific questions.

*Students who ride on a bus to and from school will follow their typical bus schedules. There will be study halls available for students to wait until 2:10 PM.
