After School Clubs & Activities Spring 2025

- Our Spring 2025 session begins the week of *April 7th*, 2025.
- **Student absences cannot be made up or refunded.** In the event of a school closure due to inclement weather or a program teacher's absence, there will be one make-up class at the end of the session. We will notify you of this schedule change.
- At 3:30 p.m., kindergarten through 8th-grade students will have a snack provided by the school, then be picked up by the program instructor and escorted to their club location.
- Parent pick-up for kindergarten through 8th-grade students is at 4:30 p.m. Club instructors will dismiss students to their parents, who will wait in the main lobby, or at the front entrance.
- If students go into After School Child Care following the club, Aftercare rates will apply starting at 4:30 p.m.
- If a club is canceled, the instructor or Ms. Pacheco will call parents and provide the rescheduled date. All dismissal changes for any canceled club must be called/emailed to the front office.
- No refunds are permitted. Students may apply their credit to switch to another club running during the same season. Returned payments are allotted only if clubs do not run and you do not wish to apply to another.
- There are no refunds or prorated payments for missed club days.

The cost of a club for kindergarten through 8th grade is **\$225.00**. Some clubs may have a different fee or materials fee applied. 
