#### State Wide Assessments - MCA/MTAS

Hamilton Ridge third, fourth and fifth grade students will be taking the Minnesota Comprehensive Assessments (MCA or MTAS) tests following Spring Break during the last two weeks of April and the first 2 weeks of May. A complete schedule for each grade level is below.

Please schedule appointments and vacations around testing dates. Participation in statewide assessments is important as it provides both the school district and the state with information regarding how students are learning. This information can serve as a guide to grade levels or subject areas where additional support may be needed.



#### Supporting Families = Supporting Kids

#### **Empathy: An Important Skill To Teach Children**

#### **Key Strategies to Teach Your Child Empathy:**

- Acknowledge and validate emotions: let your child know their feelings are important and that it's okay to express them.
- Use "I" statements: when talking about a situation, explain how you feel using "I" statements to help them understand their perspective.
- Read stories with complex emotions: discuss the character's feelings and how their actions impact others
- Role-play different scenarios: practice taking turns playing different roles to understand different perspectives
- Ask open-ended questions: encourage critical thinking by asking questions like "How do you think they felt?" or "What could they have done differently?"
- Teach emotional vocabulary: help your child identify and name their emotions, as well as the emotions of others
- Encourage acts of kindness: promote helping others and doing kind things for others, even small gestures
- Be a positive role model: demonstrate empathy in your own interactions with others
- Discuss real-life situations: use situations from your family, school, and community to talk about empathy

#### <u>Important Points to Remember:</u>

- Start early: empathy can be developed at a young age
- Be patient: developing empathy takes time and practice
- Be consistent: incorporate empathy into your daily interactions
- Adapt to your child's age: adjust activities and conversations to match their developmental level


