



Based on your response to the last question, are you planning to have children in the future?




What means of transportation is your student(s) typically using?












How likely are you to send your child to Lakewood City Schools' preschool if before and after care are available?









How likely are you to send your child to Lakewood City Schools' preschool if the location is centralized?






Do you live in the Lakewood City School District?



LAKEWOOD CITY SCHOOLS COMMUNITY SURVEY FOR ELEMENTARY FACILITIES SURVEY RESULTS **755 Total Responses**

- Familiar faces, both friends and staff members (30%, 277 respondents)
- Being able to tour the building, meet staff, have some sort of orientation event prior to moving to the building (19.6%, 148 respondents)
- Still being able to walk to school (14.57%, 110 respondents)
- Don't close any building/my child's building (12.58%, 95 respondents)
- Implementing bussing/assistance with transportation (6.89%, 52 respondents)
- Plenty of prior notice to closure/changes (6.49%, 49 respondents)
- Need for additional crossing guards (5.3%, 40 respondents)
- Availability of counseling services (2.78%, 21 respondents)






- Do not close (31.62%, 327 respondents)
 - Redistricting over closing
 - Concerns of the social-emotional impacts of the change partnered with the pandemic
- Walkability and safety 1.5+ being too far (27.37%, 283 respondents)
- Many had questions on the enrollment data and its validity, particularly as it relates to the COVID pandemic (15.28%, 158 respondents)
- Preferences for decentralized preschool preferred at each elementary due to logistics of getting children to buildings (6.29%, 65 respondents)
- Approximately 20% did not fall within a particular category, noting curriculum or special education models, support for repurposing, parent or staff involvement, or notes for consideration (20.31%, 210 respondents). • A few noted that complaints will be present regardless of the decision (0.48%, 5 respondents)

- Community center or center for adult education (12.83%, 101 respondents) • Other school option, such as moving FSO or opening a satellite university campus

- Housing units, especially for seniors (6.23%, 49 respondents)
- Arts space (4.7%, 37 respondents)
- Before/after care, tutoring (4.45%, 35 respondents)
- Office space (4.45%, 49 respondents)
- Selling the property (3.3%, 26 respondents)
- Athletic facility (3.18%, 25 respondents)
- Shopping/restaurants (2.8%, 22 respondents)
