GOVERNMENT ASSISTANCE

DES Food Stamps [aka Nutrition Assistance or Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)]

Description: Electronic benefits card is issued to allow families to purchase food at grocery stores.

Cost: Free

Eligibility: Depends on the household's size, income, and expenses

How to Apply: Apply online and/or screen for eligibility.

Arizona Self Help

Description: Free and easy website that can help you find out if your family can get help from 40 different health and human services programs including government programs such as food stamps, WIC, summer food, emergency food, welfare, AHCCCS (medical), child care assistance, and federal housing assistance. Provides one-stop access to program descriptions, contacts, applications, and lists of items to bring to eligibility interviews.

How to use: Go to website and fill in the online form. No personal identifying information is required. The Prescott Library has public computers, if needed.
