### PRIMARY CARE CLINICS

#### **Partners for Healthy Students (Yavapai Regional Medical Center)**

Description: Provides free primary, preventive, and vision care. Offers check-ups, treatment of acute and chronic illnesses, prescriptions, medication monitoring, sports physicals. Refers to but does not cover the cost of specialty care. Guardian must be present at appointment.

Cost: Free

Eligibility: **School Based Health Clinics** : Serves students and their siblings who are uninsured, underinsured, or those insured with high deductibles. Student or sibling must attend Chino Valley, Humboldt or Prescott Unified School Districts, or local charter schools.

**Mobile Health Clinic:** Serves students and their siblings who are uninsured, insured with high deductibles or covered by AHCCCS or KidsCare. Serves Kirkland, Hillside, Mayer, Paulden, Yarnell and Wilhoit.

How to Apply: Parent can call to schedule an appointment or School Nurse can refer.

#### **Community Health Center of Yavapai (County Health)**

Description: Provides primary care, including well child screenings, vaccinations, treatment of acute and chronic illness, diagnostic testing by referral, and pharmacy services by referral. Provides immunizations. Offers dental services for their patients.

Cost: Sliding scale fees for uninsured patients. Also accepts AHCCCS and other insurance. Eligibility: No restrictions. Insurance is not required.

Description: Offers insurance programs for low income people. Covers medical, dental and vision services for children under 21.

Eligibility: Based on income and other requirements.

How to Apply: Fill out an online application on the website above or call for information on filling out a paper application.

## **Health Insurance Marketplace (aka Affordable Care Act, Healthcare Reform, Obamacare, or Healthcare Exchange)** Phone: 800-318-2596

Description: Marketplace for private insurance plans. Subsidies are offered for lower income people.

Cost: Varies. Subsidies are based on family size and income.

Eligibility: All U.S. citizens. Only limitation may be by immigration status.

How to Apply: Has a limited open enrollment period. Open for enrollment through Dec. 15 for coverage the following Jan. 1. Apply on the website or call toll free number above.

### **Salvation Army**

Description: Volunteer doctor and nurse offer care for current, critical problems on Mondays at 8am.

Cost: Free

Eligibility: Anyone in need.

How to Apply: Must arrive at 237 S. Montezuma St. by 8:00am to be seen. Go to the front of breakfast line and ask for clinic line.

### **Medical Services Project (American Academy of Pediatrics)**

Description: Provides one-time diagnostic services for primary care, specialty referrals, dental, vision, and laboratory providers for acute problems & prescription medications. Most providers are in the Phoenix area, but a few are in the Prescott area.

Cost: Usually \$5-10 per visit

Eligibility: Serves Arizona children with current, critical healthcare needs. Children must be uninsured and from low-income families who do not otherwise qualify for health care coverage.

How to Apply: School Nurse must refer the student to the program
