Apply for Admission

Students can start by visiting **deltacollege.edu**. To begin, in the upper right-hand corner, click the yellow "APPLY" icon and then the "Start Your Application" icon. First, create the CCCApply account and then complete the application for Delta College. After submitting the application, students should receive a welcome email with their student ID number within 2 business days.

Access Your MyDelta Dashboard

Students will receive a series of emails after applying to Delta College. One of those will provide students with their Delta ID number, their Delta College email address, and a link prompting them to activate their MyDelta Dashboard. Students need to activate their account and set a password. For assistance, students can use the "Need Help Signing In" link at the bottom of the MyDelta Dashboard login page, contact the Mustang Tech Squad through the online chat at **bit.ly/MustangTechSquad**, or visit the Delta Connect Center (DCC) located on the first floor of the DeRicco Student Services Building.

Complete New Student Orientation

Students can access New Student Orientation through their "TASKS" tile in their MyDelta portal. There are multiple ways to complete the orientation. Completing the New Student Orientation is required to meet priority registration criteria.

Meet with a Delta College Counselor

Where can I go for IN-PERSON SUPPORT?

The Delta Connect Center (DCC) on the 1st floor of the DeRicco Student Services Building (look for the colorful pillars), which is open Monday through Friday, 8:00 am - 5:00 pm and until 7:00 pm on Wednesday--or Administration office at the South Campus in Mountain House. Services include: Admissions and Records, Financial Aid, Career Transfer, Counseling, and more (**bit.ly/DeltaDCC**).

What if I forgot my MYDELTA DASHBOARD password *or* if I never got my student account email after applying to Delta College?

On the sign in page click on "Need Help Signing in?" and follow the prompts. If you're still having difficulty, contact the Mustang Tech Squad through the online chat at **bit.ly/MustangTechSquad** or visit the DCC in person.

How do I REGISTER for classes?

Course registration must be done online. Visit the "How to Register" webpage for more info using this link **bit.ly**/**DC_REG_T**. If you're still having trouble, contact Admissions and Records or visit the DCC.

The semester already started, can I still REGISTER for classes?

Yes, Delta College offers late-starting classes, so students can apply and register even after a term has started. View the "Open Class List" for more info.

How do I FIND MY CLASSROOM at Delta College?

Use the campus maps on the website to familiarize yourself with building names and locations. Classroom numbers in the 100s are on the first floor, 200s are on the second floor, and so on. Remember Delta College has multiple locations including sites in Lodi, Manteca, and Mountain House.

How do I access my ONLINE CLASSES?

Log into MyDelta Dashboard and click on the Canvas tile. Each of your online classes will have its own unique icon. The following webpage has more info about all online services: **bit.ly/SJDCOnline**.

Do I have to PAY FOR PARKING?

Yes, starting Fall 2024, parking permits will be required for anyone parking on campus (**bit.ly/DC_ParkingInfo**). Students in certain programs are eligible for free public transportation services through San Joaquin RTD.

When do I get my STUDENT ID CARD?

Starting the first week of school visit the DCC or the Student Activities Office (Shima 101C). You must first be enrolled in class(es) to obtain your ID.

Can HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS take Delta College classes?

Yes, students who are at least 14 years old and enrolled in high school can take Delta classes. Most classes are FREE.
