

Rutland City School budget

A brief message to the voters in Rutland City regarding Fiscal Year 2026 school budget:

The current student weighting system provides a great benefit to the children of Rutland City, offering a more equitable funding formula to help meet the diverse needs of our community.

Thus, about three-quarters of every dollar spent in the Rutland City school budget comes from state and federal government funds, not the local taxpayer.

If projections hold, expect the homestead property tax rate to drop by 6 cents.
