When you choose doctors and hospitals in your network, you can help save money and enjoy a more convenient experience.

When you're away from home

When you or your eligible dependents travel or go to school away from home, AmeriHealth Administrators gives you access to network doctors and hospitals across the U.S. using PHCS *Healthy Directions* travel network.

The travel network doctors and hospitals are considered in-network *only* when you travel or go to school outside your primary network's service area.¹ Otherwise, health care providers are in-network *only if* they are in the AmeriHealth Administrators network or other network shown on the front of your ID card.

Choosing network doctors and hospitals can save you money

If you use a non-network provider, your plan's out-of-network benefits apply. Also, nonnetwork providers may require that you pay their full charge when you receive care, and they may bill you for amounts over what your plan pays. You could pay significantly more out of your pocket if you choose a non-network provider.

Network providers cannot bill you for amounts that exceed your plan's network allowance. They may bill you only for copays, deductible, coinsurance, and amounts that exceed your plan's maximum benefits.
