Communicated with counselors from both high schools to review the survey process.



Anonymous responses = 0





Class of 2020 Gender Responses (Optional question)




Historical Gender Responses




Class of 2020 Ethnicity Responses













Attending a 4-year college program in NY




Attending a 4-year college program outside of NY







Historical comparison of the survey question "Did you change colleges during your undergraduate experience?"




Historical comparison of the survey question "If you transferred to a different college, why?"








"Have you changed jobs since graduation?"




Historical comparison of the survey question "Have you changed jobs since graduation?"

"What technology tools do you currently use/access most?"



"What advice would you give to a high school student today?" Themes that emerged from responses:

Self-Discovery and Authenticity: Encouragement to be true to oneself, explore personal interests, and not be afraid to stand out or change paths.


Education and Learning: Emphasis on applying oneself, taking diverse classes, and building good study habits.

Balance and Well-being: Advice on balancing work and life, enjoying experiences, and not stressing too much about grades or immediate career decisions.

Community and Involvement: Importance of being involved in the community, making connections, and participating in extracurricular activities.

Future Planning and Flexibility: Guidance on planning for the future, being open to new opportunities, and understanding that it's okay to change one's mind or path.

Basic Life Knowledge: Classes that teach

practical life skills such as insurance, healthcare, and other adult responsibilities.
Students feel unprepared for realworld tasks despite having academic knowledge.



Job Search Strategies and Interviewing:

Courses that help students with job search strategies, applying for jobs, interviewing techniques, and career building.



Basic Coding and Computer Science:

There is a strong interest in learning basic coding (such as Python or R) and computer science principles. Students feel that these skills are essential for modern careers.



General Post-Grad or Adult Life Skills:

Classes that prepare students for life after high school, including renting an apartment and buying a home.

This also includes practical cooking classes and mental health education.
