




Parent Portal

Allows parents/guardians and students (secondary only) to access student information including assignments and grades, register students for the upcoming school year, and receive school communications.





Pages in the portal, minus the Home page, display information based on the student selected in the upper right hand corner of the page. To see data for a different student, select the student from the drop down list.






Elementary Grading Information








Secondary: Grade Book Update View


