# Arrival: 7:15-7:42 (Gate Open 7:15 Shuts at 7:42)


\*\*Arrivals 7:42 or later need to go to the front office. An adult should walk the student inside and sign them in.

Cars will enter single file through the bottom driveway (farthest away from the building).

Cars will drive single file through the drive and and stop at the thick white line. This will allow around 5-6 cars to drop off at one time. Adults will be present at the drop off line. Do not pass cars in line.

Parents/Caregivers should remain in their car while dropping off their student. If you child is in a car seat please teach them how to unbuckle. Have backpacks ready. Give an I love you have a great day. Students should exit the vehicle on the passengers side as much as possible. Please have students open the car door from the inside and exit.

Cars will exit single file through the parking lot driveway.



#### Dismissal: 2:45

\*\*Arrivals after car rider line is complete need to go to the front office for pick with identification.


Parents/Caregivers will double stack both lanes of the driveway for dismissal. Please line up closely so as not to leave cars on the street if possible. First arrivals stop at the gate.

Before dismissal begins the gate will be open by staff. Give your student(s) transportation card at the gate. Both lanes will proceed to the thick white line.


Students will come out in two lines as identified in **blue** (1) and **pink** (2). Once all students are loaded into cars line 1 will released to the exit while new cars pull forward. Then line 2 will exit and new cars pull forward.

Please put your car in park and do NOT exit your car when students arrive at the vehicle.

As we run our new procedure please understand adjustments may need to be made as we reflect and refine. All updates will be communicated. We will have extra staff to help during the first week of school.
