Dear Parents,


It's hard to believe it is February already! Our 1st ever <u>One Book One</u> <u>School</u> begins on February 3, 2025. You should have received a letter on January 31st to explain the process and see the timeline. We encourage families to read together with their children. You also received a packet of activities to do together at home.

The Session 2 <u>After School Academic Intervention Service</u> (AIS) will begin on 2-24-25 and run through 5-15-25. K-2 meets on Mondays and Tuesdays. Grades 3, 4, 5, and 6 meet on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday from 3:30-4:30 p.m. The first session was a huge success with students growing in both ELA & Math on their assessments. Invitations were sent home via backpack. <u>Please return if you are</u> <u>declining so we can invite another student.</u>

We understand many children have gotten ill during the winter time, so it is important when they are **not** sick to come to school. Save those absences for days they are sick. NYS guidelines states *"more than 10% is excessive."* That equates to more than 18 days, means your child is missing quality instruction. When they are not in school, children get behind and tend to dislike school because they can't keep up with their work. Did you realize we only have about 20 days per month of school? So, missing more than 18 days is like missing a month of school. *Phone calls will be made to those with excessive absences and possibly a home visit.*

Beginning in April the NY State Assessments will begin. Please see the chart below for dates. The assessments are only two days and are completed in the morning. It's a method to obtain data. The results do not go on your child's report card or cumulative file. The data is for the teachers to analyze. *It is very important that our students take the assessment, so we can obtain data to determine which standards our students are strong in or weak in to adjust our lesson plans accordingly*. We strongly encourage that your child take these tests. Teachers have worked diligently to have your children prepared. Most schools in Ulster County are back to almost all of their students taking the tests. Opt out rates are extremely low.
