CAPITAL PROJECT REVIEW AND AUTHORIZATION TO PROCEED

The Pennsauken Planning Board made the following recommendations to National Energy Partners, LLC:

- 1. The solar arrays on the roofs of the above-mentioned schools and Administration Building be allowed to move forward.
- 2. Insure that students are protected during construction.
- 3. Provide adequate property and casualty insurance to protect the constituents of Pennsauken.

FURTHERMORE, after hearing the testimony and considering the plans presented, the roof solar arrays be allowed to proceed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Planning Board of Pennsauken makes the following recommendations to the New Jersey Board of Education, Facilities Department;

- 1. Insure that students are protected during construction
- 2. Provide adequate property and casualty insurance to protect the constituents of Pennsauken.
