PUBLIC HEARING

Description of Project - The proposed capital improvement project consists of: (i) renovations and improvements to the School District's facilities to convert existing space into an Electrical Construction Lab for educational purposes; (ii) construction of a new Welding Lab for educational purposes; and (iii) the completion of such other work and improvements and acquisition of furniture, fixtures and equipment as may be necessary therefore or related to completion of the aforementioned capital improvement program; all as further described in the information prepared in connection therewith and on file in the offices of the Business Administrator/Board Secretary.

Total Estimated Cost - \$2,000,000

Proposed Method of Financing Local Share – Five (5) year lease purchase transaction pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:20-4.2(f).
