BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED to withdrawal from Capital Reserve – Other Capital Projects. Included in budget line 620. Budgeted withdrawal from Capital Reserve – Excess Costs and Other Capital Projects, is \$1,987,500 for the following Capital Projects:

- Air Conditioning \$372,500
- Pennsauken High School \$1,615,000

The total costs of these projects is \$1,987,500 which represents expenditures for construction elements or projects that are in addition to the facilities efficiency standards determined by the Commissioner as necessary to achieve the core curriculum content standards.

2. **RECOMMEND** the Board of Education of the Township of Pennsauken approve the following resolution:

WHEREAS N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-7.3(a) provides that the Board of Education shall establish in the annual school budget a maximum expenditure amount that may be allotted for such travel and expense reimbursement for 2017-2018 school year; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Pennsauken Board of Education hereby establishes the school district travel maximum for the 2017-2018 school year at the sum of \$70,000; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the School Business Administrator shall track and record these costs to insure that the maximum amount is not exceeded.

3. **RECOMMEND** the Board of Education of the Township of Pennsauken approve the following resolution:

WHEREAS N.J.A.C. 6A:23A – 5.2 requires the Pennsauken Township Board of Education to establish maximum annual dollar items during budget preparation for dissemination of public information.
